Dear Centaurs,

Well done if you have successfully logged into MySchool from home and found your AQE practice papers! This information page will give you some helpful hints about how to carry out these papers.

Suggested weekly timetable:

Monday: complete the paper called 'Monday Paper' in the folder 'Week 1'. Each week we will add another folder called 'Week 2', 'Week 3' etc... Allow your parent/ carer to mark the paper. You should continue with some work in another topic e.g. WAU, PE.

Tuesday: go through Monday's marked paper with your parent/ carer. Use the paper and your revision pack to focus on an area of learning you may have found challenging in the paper.

Wednesday: complete the paper called 'Wednesday Paper' in the folder 'Week 1'. Allow your parent/ carer to mark the paper. You should continue with some work from your weekly home learning grid. E.g. probability in maths.

Thursday: go through Wednesday's marked paper with your parent/ carer. Use the paper and your revision pack to focus on an area of learning you may have found challenging in the paper.

Friday: refer to the weekly home learning grid and complete remaining Literacy & Numeracy tasks.

Helpful Hints

There may be some questions that you do not know how to do yet. But remember, do not panic, you can only **TRY YOUR BEST!**



Write your name and date on the front of your paper/ pages you use to complete the paper.



Read each question at **least twice** and **remember to underline key words**.



If you leave a question out put a large **X** at the top of the page so the question is easy to find again.



Show your working out!



Remember the answer may not always be obvious, you may have to 'read between the lines', especially in the comprehension passages.



Keep an **eye** on the **time**. You have **60 minutes** to complete each paper.



Check you haven't left any questions out. Even if you're not sure, have a go!



Check your answers if you have time.



Stay calm.
